Criteria to serve as a Visiting Expert:

- » An ASLMS member in good standing
- » At least two years out of formal training or a minimum of one year after fellowship and have teaching and leadership experience
- » A recognized ASLMS Conference/Course speaker within the last five years
- » Recognized by peers as an expert in the specialty topic on which the lecture is focused
- » Include ASLMS prepared components (ASLMS branded slides, ASLMS member benefits slides)
- » American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) certification required if applicable

Steps to serve as a Visiting Expert:

- 1. Current curriculum vitae
- 2. Documentation proving applicant holds a current academic appointment at an accredited university
- 3. List of references
- 4. Provide current biography for posting on the ASLMS website
- 5. Provide picture for posting on the ASLMS website
- 6. Complete and sign Visiting Expert Release form
